# Admissions Policy

We therefore:							

- Consider students who have EAL needs.
- Consider students who have learning support needs.
- In offering admission, our ethical principle is that we only do so if we feel we are able to meet and support the students' needs.
- -In admitting a student, we look closely at the context of the class into which they would enter.
- If a shadow teacher is deemed necessary then that will be considered, provided the parents are prepared to support the additional expense.
- The school reserves the right to refuse admission in the case of inaccurate information being submitted.



# How to Apply

Prospective students who wish to apply to St. Andrews International School Dusit will need to complete an application form and pay an Application Fee in order to be considered against the admissions criteria and be offered a place. Applications are considered in chronological order of reciept. We welcome new applications throughout the academic year.

The Second Step

Once these documents have been submitted and the application fee has been recieved, the Admissions Office will review the application file. More information may be requeted from you or the previous school. St. Andrews will then contact your family to schedule age specific assessments in English and maths, and a meeting with the Head of School, Deputy Head of School or EAL/SEND department as appropriate. You will then be notified whether your child has met the criteria for admission.



#### \*\*Please note:

- Early Years students are assessed by completing informal and practical activities in the classroom during their trial session.
- Primary students undertake an informal English assessment and a non-language based mathematics assessment.
- Although admission to our school is open to students of all nationalities, as the main language of instruction is English, full participation in our curriculum requires proficiency in the English language. For students from Reception to Year 6 we offer a limited number of places on our EAL programme.
- Following the trial day, class teachers will meet with parents of students and either agree to enrol or identify additional support needed. At this stage, a language choice should be made (Mandarin, Bilingual Thai, French or German).

## The Third Step

When a place is offered, the entrance fee must be paid within seven (7) days. If the enrolment fee is not received within these seven (7) days, priority will be given to other applicants. The first installment of tuitions fees is due June 1st for August entry. For students commencing during the academic year, the tuition fee is due within 7 days after the invoice date. The medical examination form must be completed and returned prior to the student's start date.

# Waiting List

f a place is not available at the time you wish to join, your child's name will be placed on a waiting list and you will be notified as soon as a vacancy is anticipated. Please notify the Admissions Office of any changes to address or other contact details, or if your circumstances change.

# Special Needs

The school has limited resources for students who have physical or learning difficulties and therefore admissions, in such cases, is determined by the school on a case by case basis.

# School Changes

The school as any other, is likely to undergo a number of changes during the time your child is here. For example, there may be changes in staff, in the premises, facilities and their use in, the curriculum, the size and composition of classes, the handbook, the 'Terms and Conditions', the disciplinary framework and the length of the school year. Tuition and school fees will be regularly reviewed and adjusted annually.

# School Fee Structure

# Application Fee

4,000 Baht per child.

This fee is payable when an application is submitted and is a non-refundable administration charge.

#### Entrance Fee

This entrance fee is payable upon initial enrolment and confirmation of your place at the school. This entrance fee is non refundable. The two options are:

#### (A) Enrolment Fee, One-time lump sum fee

**(B) Capital Levy Fee,** This is an alternative method of paying the enrolment fee. This allows parents who stay in Bangkok for only a short period of time to have a reduced enrolment fee. The capital levy is 25,000 THB per term per child for the first 4 consecutive terms (or equal to the maximum of capital levy of 100,000 THB.

#### School Fee Refund

A refund of tuition fee, canteen fee and transportation fee will only be granted depending on the following conditions; 'when a child leaves the school before the next term starts, the parents will be refunded a full term. If the child starts a new term, the parents will be refunded for half term. However, if the child attends the second half term but leaves before its end, there will be no refund'.

#### Interest Rate for Late Payment

Fees remaining unpaid outside the invoice credit period will be subject to interest of 1.25% per month of outstanding balance until payment is recieved.

#### Student Insurance
